Level test assessments taken to measure the performance and outcome of the tuitions provided. Termly mock tests are done in order to monitor the progress of every child.

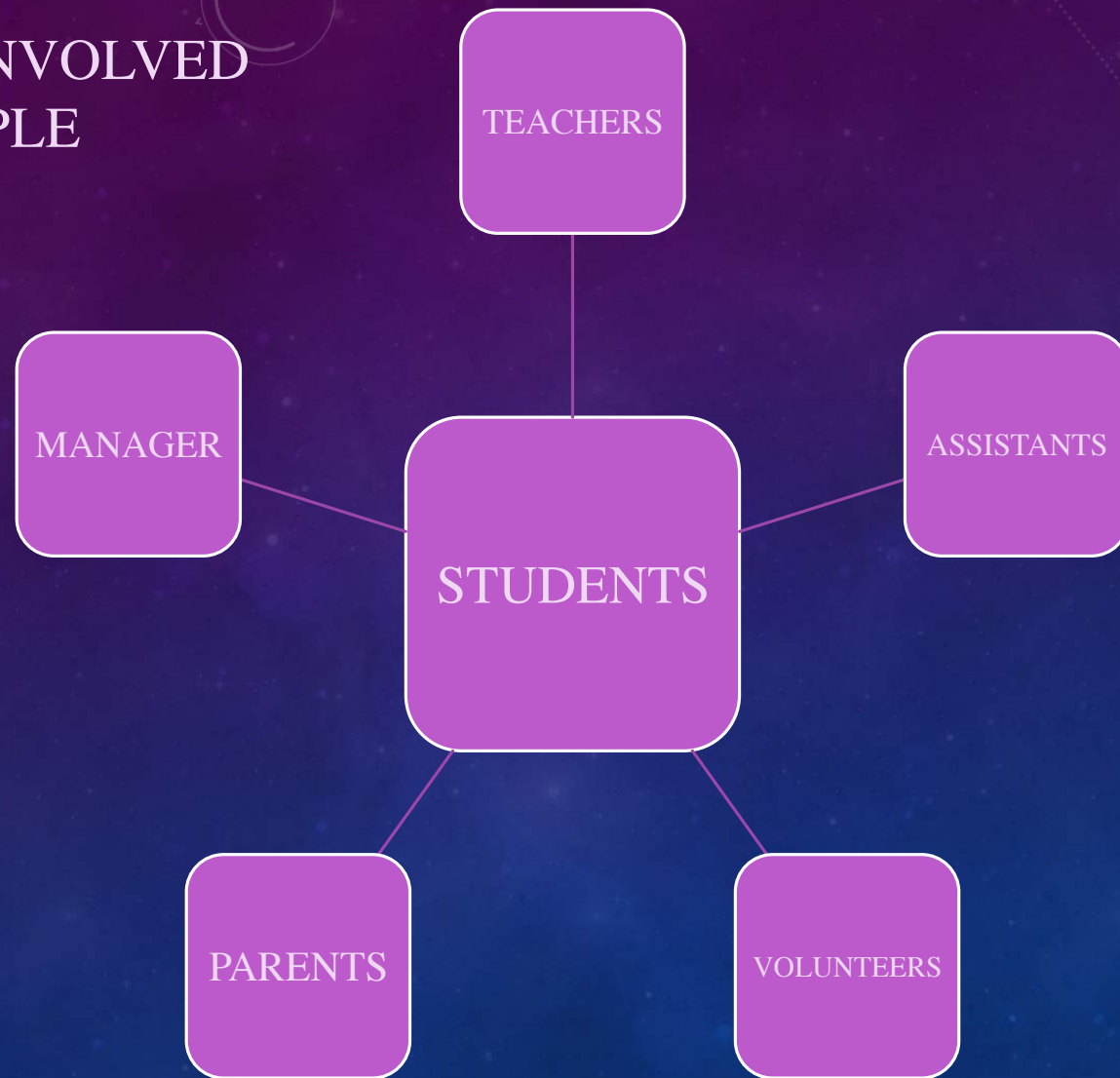
Weekly progress report cards are provided to parents to keep up the work children do in class.

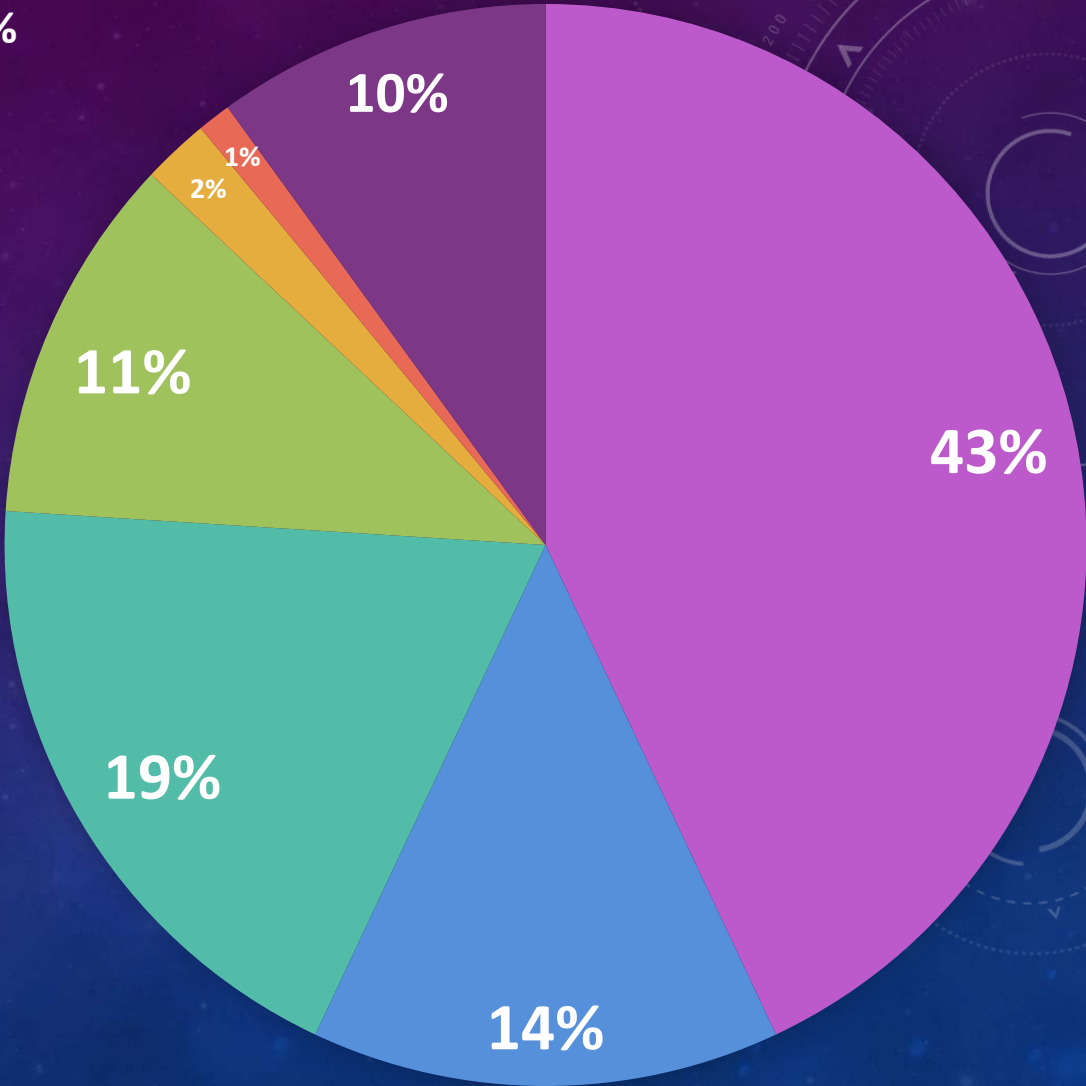

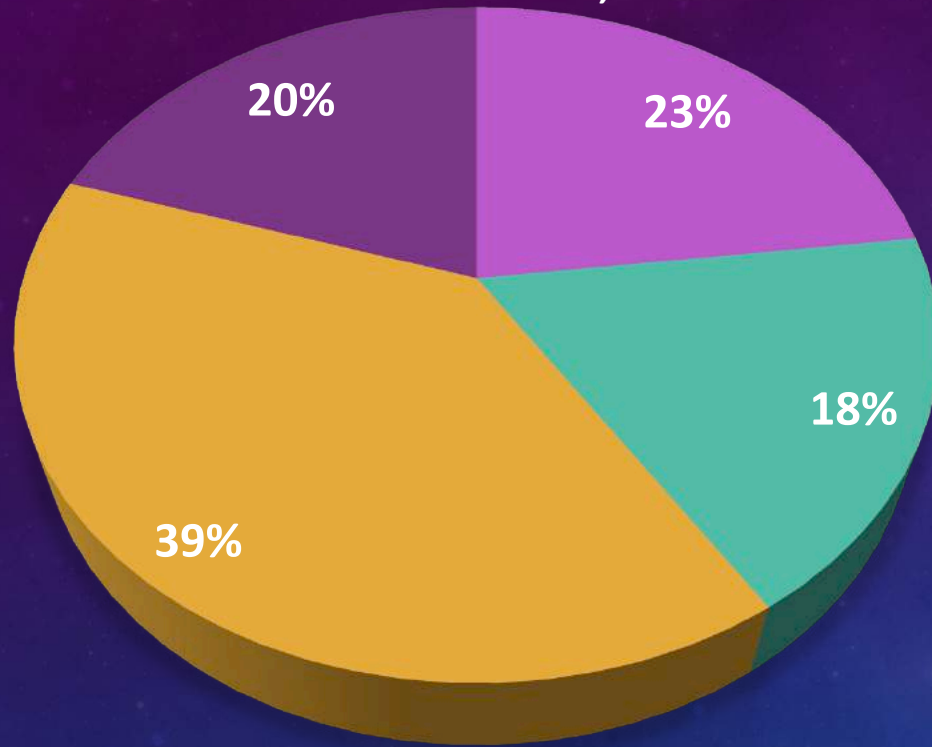


STUDENTS BY ETHNICITY, %

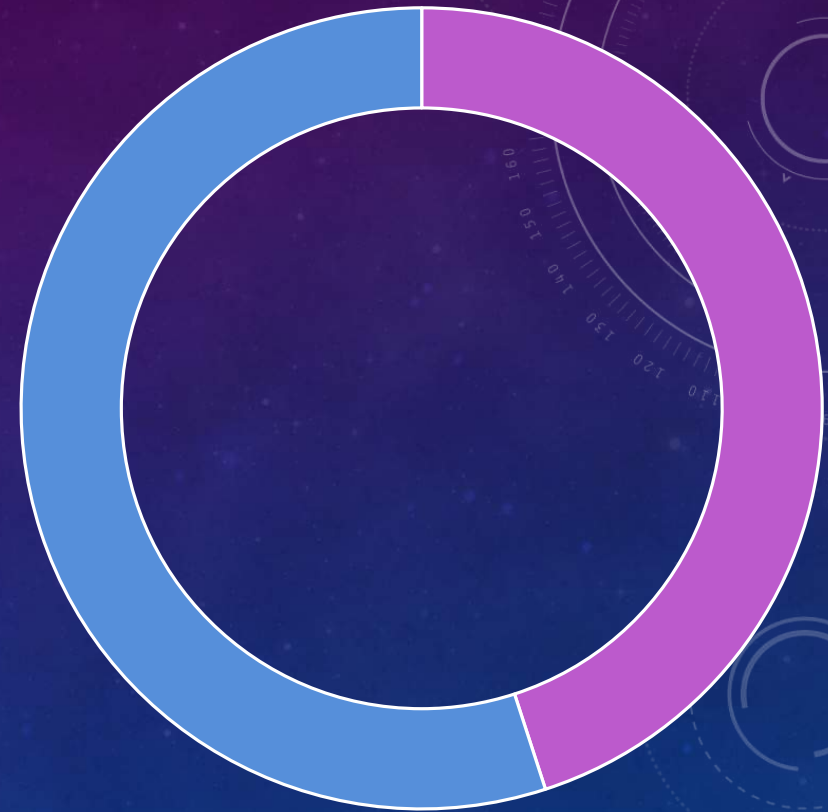

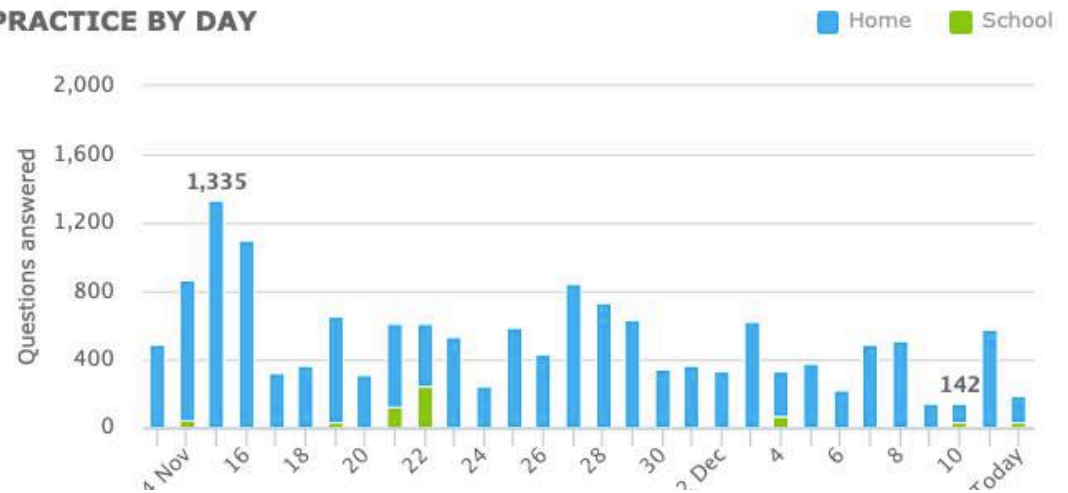

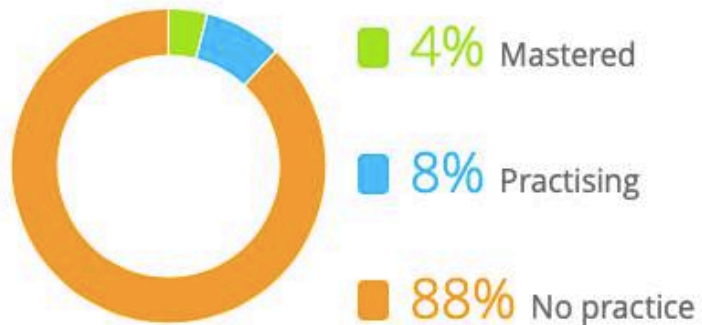



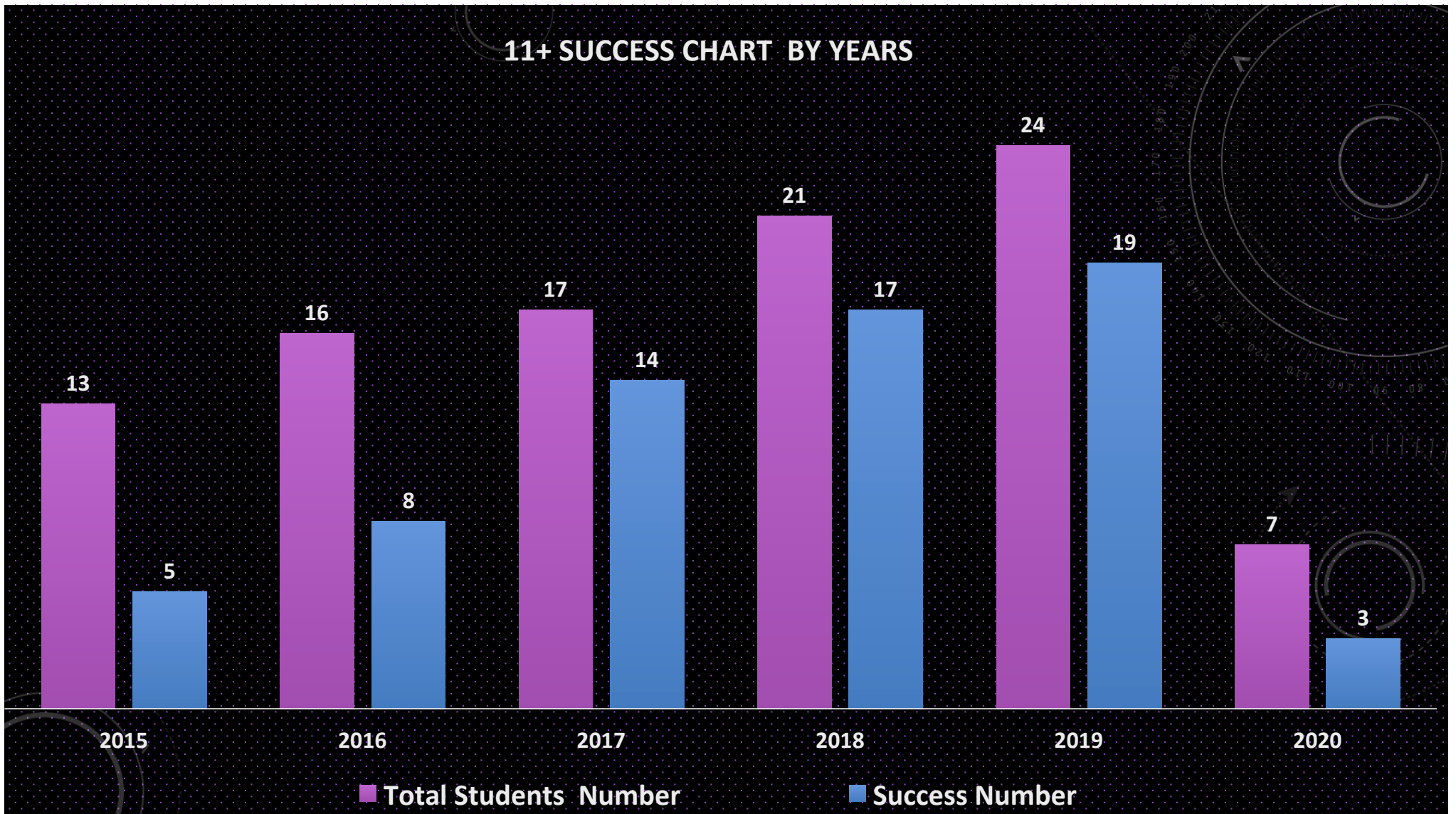

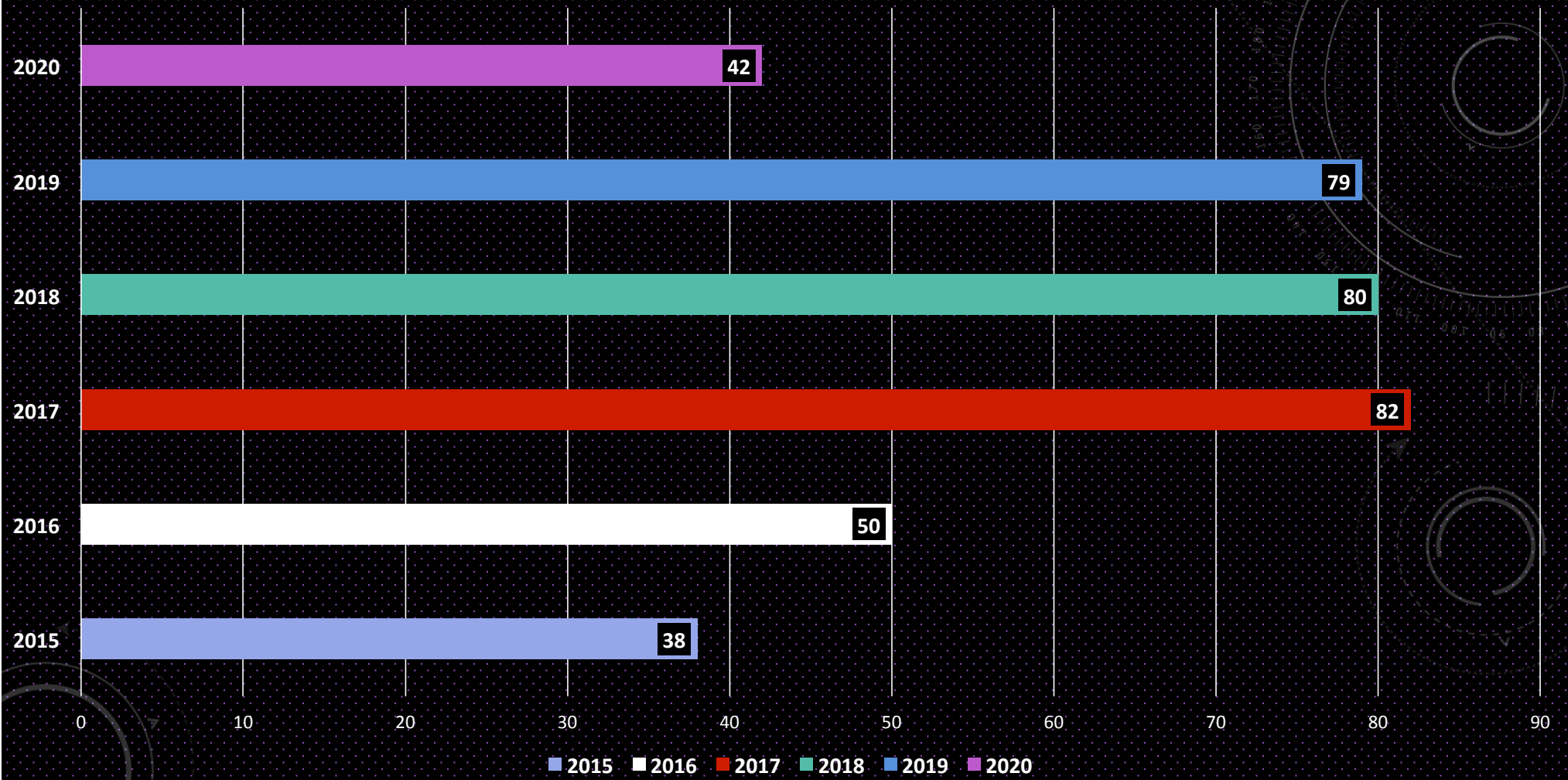
